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## REPORT 1 DAY EDUCATIONAL SESSION 1

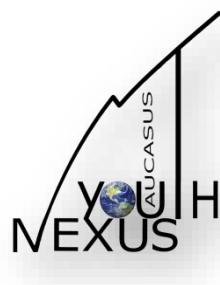
This report will include all information about one-day info session for youngsters that was organized as part of field work activities on KA2 Erasmus+ project „One Step Ahead“, which is financed by European Commission.

Info session took place in Gothenburg, Sweden on 24th of July 2019. Organizer and hosting organisation was Ung Kraft / Youth Power that is Swedish partner organisation on this project.

Info session was organized in order introduce young people with the general concepts of social entrepreneurship. Target group of this info sessions were mostly young people that have no previous experience in this topic, but have strong will and motivation to learn something new and maybe in future get idea to get self-employed or create their own enterprise. Participants could apply through the open call that was published on social network pages of our organisation, and at the end we had group of 19 people attending the event. If we analyse bit deeply general profile of participants, they were mostly women and students from local universities that would like to learn something new about topic of (social) entrepreneurship generally.

During the info session, we firstly introduced what is entrepreneurship and what is social entrepreneurship and what are their main differences and similarities. Also, we presented participants with temporary situation in Sweden regarding topics of entrepreneurship and SE, and analyse legal framework for creation of (social) enterprises. Afterwards, participants got a chance to do their own short researches and find real-life examples of (social) entrepreneurship in Sweden, and think about what positive practices they could take from them if and when they decide to create their own ideas. In the second part of the session, participants were introduced with the most important entrepreneurial skills, and useful advice on how they can gain or improve them. In the last part, special accent was put on creative and critical thinking skills of participants, but also they learned useful things such as how to create and develop business plan and basics of project management.

At the end, all participants shared their contacts so that they can share useful information and materials among each other even in the future, but also they will be able to ask for any kind of help or assistance from youth workers that are working in Ung Kraft / Youth Power. They also shared their opinions and thoughts about this info session, and feedback that we received was generally positive. All participants agreed that this session and information they received during



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it will be helpful and useful in their future. It is important to say that most of them got motivation to learn even more about (social) entrepreneurship, and maybe develop ideas for creation of their own (social) enterprises in the future.
